WAGE PREMIUMS

Foreman	Two (2) to eight (8) masons of the same trade - \$3.00/hr above Journeyman rate Nine (9) or more masons of the same trade – Six percent (6%) above Journeyman total package
Plasterers*	Spraying insulation: \$0.50 per hour additive Applying material with a gun: \$0.75 per hour additive
Suspension Work*	Preparing, erecting, or working on any suspended scaffold, swing-stage, work cage, lifts 100 ft. or greater, or boatswains/bosun’s chair: \$2.50 per hour above regular hourly scale
Certified Welder*	Certified welder performing sustained welding assignment of five hours or more per day: \$3.00 per hour above the regular hourly scale
Acid Bonding* Sandblasting* Guniting Work*	\$2.00 per hour above the regular hourly scale.
Overtime – Bricklayer	Monday – Friday: Time and one-half (1.5x) after 8/hrs per day or 40/hrs per week Saturday: Time and one-half (1.5x) unless make-up day (November – April) Sundays & Holidays: Double time (2x)
Overtime - Cement Mason	Monday – Friday: Time and one-half (1.5x) after 10/hrs per day or 40/hrs per week Saturday: Time and one half (1.5x) Sundays & Holidays: Double time (2x)
Holidays	New Years Day; Memorial Day; 4 th of July; Labor Day; Thanksgiving; Christmas Holidays that fall on a Saturday will be observed on the preceding Friday; Holidays that fall on Sunday will be observed on the following Monday
Shift Work	1 st Shift – 8 hours work for 8 hours pay 2 nd Shift – 7.5 hours work for 8 hours pay 3 rd Shift – 7 hours work for 8 hours pay

*Only one premium shall be paid during the course of any paid hour
